ST. IGNATIUS LOYOLA - FEAST DAY JULY 31

This week we celebrate a spiritual master! Not only is St. Ignatius Loyola the founder of the Jesuits, but the legacy of his life of prayer -- now called Ignatian spirituality -- inspired believers the world over. St. Ignatius was born in 1491, one of 13 children of a family of minor nobility in northern Spain. Injured as a young soldier, Ignatius spent his time in recovery reading the lives of the saints. They inspired his soul to holy heroism, changing his life forever. Ignatius gathered a group of friends who also desired to be "contemplatives in action," finding God in all circumstances. This became the Jesuits -- a great missionary and teaching order. Ignatius himself was constantly attuned to his own inner promptings. This self-knowledge -- open to the movements of the Holy Spirit -- led him to be an incredibly astute spiritual director. For Ignatius, recognizing God as the first principle of one's life determined everything. Ignatius' passed away on July 31, 1556, at the age of 64. He was beatified by Pope Paul V on July 27, 1609 and canonized on March 12, 1622. His feast day is July 31. He is the patron saint of the Society of Jesus, soldiers, educators and education.

Faith Formation Registration is now open for the 2018-2019 School year! Pick up your forms today in the Church Gathering Space, the Faith Formation Office or from our website. Classes will begin the week of September 9, 2018. All families registering after September 7, 2018 will be assessed a \$35 late fee. Any child receiving the sacraments of First Communion or Confirmation in the 2018-2019 school year will be required to present to the Faith Formation Office Original Birth Certificates and Original Sacramental Certificates. Please also note that preparation for these sacraments is a two year commitment. Enrollment in Faith Formation in first grade for First Communion and ninth grade for Confirmation is required. CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori based religious formation for children.
