#### Ways to Pray

You can pray alone. Just as you talk with your best friends and share what is going on in your life, so too can you talk to God. Just as you listen to your friends, so too can you listen to God. You can pray to God in your own words. You can pray with others in communal prayer. When you pray with others, you may rely on the traditional prayers that unite us in our catholic Way of Life. You can pray silently or aloud. You can pray using different postures and gestures: genuflecting, kneeling, standing, bowing, folding your hands, and praying the Sign of the Cross. There are many options from which to choose. You can pray anytime-while you are relaxing, working, walking or playing.

#### Forms of Prayer

Sometimes you might bless or adore God for his greatness (prayer of blessing and adoration). Other times you might ask God for something for yourself, asking God's forgiveness for your sins, or asking him to grant your needs (prayer of petition). Sometimes you might pray for others (prayer of intercession). When you ask on behalf of another, you pray as Jesus did when he interceded with God for all of us in the words of the Lord's Prayer. You might also thank God in prayer for his gifts to you (prayer of thanksgiving). Finally, you might give praise to God (prayer of Praise), recognizing that God is God, and giving him glory for his being. You can even try some quiet prayer with the Blessed Sacrament. We call this form of prayer, Adoration. At St. Joseph, adoration is available on Mondays, Tuesdays or Wednesdays in the Day Chapel.

Come spend time with Jesus. He is waiting for you!
