2020 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM CRITERIA

1. This Scholarship program will be funded by the Catholic Daughters of the Americas Court #2260. It is declared to be a Youth Educational Project.
2. The Scholarship Award will be for a total of \$1000.00 for the year 2020 granted to Two (2) qualified graduating High School students in the amount of \$500.00 each.
3. Those eligible to make application must be students completing their senior year in high school and graduating in this calendar year. The applicant must have been accepted or anticipates acceptance at an accredited college, university, or vocational school, and must intend to be a full time student. The applicant must be a practicing Catholic and be a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church - Honey Creek; or a family member (i.e. child, stepchild, or grandchild) of a member of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas Court #2260.
4. The Regent of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas Court #2260, as Advisor, along with four (4) active members will serve on the Scholarship Recipient Committee. The identity of the committee members will not be revealed outside the meeting room of the respective organizations.
5. The completed application form, along with a personal letter outlining the applicant's goals, and three reference letters must be submitted to the Parish office **NO later than 4:00 p.m. FRIDAY May 8, 2020**. Application and accompanying documents should be placed in a **SEALED ENVELOPE and ADDRESSED** to the attention of:
